

Graduate Research Assistantship

We have **one** opening for a Graduate Research Assistantship. This positions will be working on a research project focusing on passenger rail in California.

To be eligible for the assistantship, the candidate must be admitted as a full-time graduate student in the SF State Recreation, Parks, & Tourism Master of Science program.

Description

Requires 20-hours of work per week. This is a 9-month appointment.

Duties include primary and secondary data collection, data analysis, reporting, administrative duties, and other duties as assigned. This position will require overnight travel.

Benefits

Funding is available for this position for the entire two-year duration of a Master's program.

- Tuition: full-time (18 credits/year), in-state or out-of-state
- Stipend: Minimum of \$16,500 annually
