THE INTERNSHIP

Out & About offers an internship in Therapeutic Recreation, supervised by a Certified Therapeutic Recreation Specialist. The purpose of the internship is to provide students with a professional, educational, and enjoyable internship by offering the opportunity to work with people that have developmental disabilities. The Out & About program is focused on offering quality Therapeutic Recreation services in a community-based setting. As an intern, you may facilitate art, movement, sports activities and much more!

Out & About provides recreation activities in three areas:

1) Catalog Services provide classes and one time events to adults during evenings and weekends. There are also day time classes that happen on weekdays.

2) After School Program provides services to school age participants. Students are picked up from school and transported to various community based activities.

3) Summer Camp is a day camp service June through August, featuring full days of activities for school age participants.
