## JOB SUMMARY

Under the supervision of the Therapeutic Recreation Supervisor, responsible to plan, organize, lead, participate in and supervise activities for individuals with special needs in recreation programs in a safe environment.

### **EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE & TRAINING**

- Must be at least 16 years of age
- Experience or desire to work with individuals with disabilities
- Certification in first aid and CPR
- Must have transportation to and from program sites

# **KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES**

- Knowledge of specialty field requirements
- Ability to display a positive attitude and appropriately interact with individuals with disabilities
- Ability to lead program and make necessary accommodations for individuals with disabilities of various ages
- Enthusiasm and commitment in providing recreation opportunities for individuals with disabilities

### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Lead/assist in the recreation activities for various special populations in a variety of community based programs
- Actively participate in program activities
- Supervise participants with disabilities at all times. This will include behavior management, personal care and assisting in daily living skills (feeding, toileting, clothing) and activity accommodations as needed
- Assist individuals in wheelchairs, including lifting, transferring and pushing
- Work effectively with parents, park district staff and other community contact
- Assist in wheelchair lift and tie downs on LCSRA vehicle
- Complete necessary paperwork as required
- Report any problems or concerns to the Therapeutic Recreation Supervisor
- Other duties as assigned by the Therapeutic Recreation Supervisor
- Attend meetings and training sessions as scheduled
- Perform related duties as assigned and sub as needed
- Perform all job tasks within the rules and guidelines of the Park District's safety program
- Work as a Team Player with co-workers and in conjunction with other departments

# PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Talking/Hearing: to communicate with staff and participants

Sitting: to position a participant.

Reaching: to retrieve supplies or participant.

Pulling: to open doors and drawers. Pushing: to close doors and drawers.

Stooping: to retrieve supplies from lower levels. Crouching: to retrieve supplies from lower levels. Seeing: to obtain information from written materials.

Holding: to immobilize participant during behavior outbreaks.

Lifting: to move equipment and supplies, to set up and take down activities, to transfer participants

# **COGNITIVE CONSIDERATIONS**

Must have the ability to read, write and organize materials. Must have the ability to develop and administer a simple budget. Must be able to relate to other people in a professional manner. Must exhibit good safety awareness and judgment.
